**MINUTES**

District General Manager Deschenes opened the Public Meeting, introducing the Board and the Aquatics Manager to the audience. He briefly summarized the remodel currently in progress at the Mt. Rainier Pool and indicated the facility was scheduled to re-open sometime around mid-January 2018.

Keith Hayes from BRS explained the purpose of the 3<sup>rd</sup>, and last, Public Meeting in the series with regard to the Aquatic Feasibility Study. The agenda was presented.

Keith directed his comments to the present site options and summarized each location by size and program components based on the survey and public meetings.

Questions from the public included those on solar options, energy efficiency, facility life span, and additional parking. Comments were made regarding the slide option that was presented in several designs and the need for that option.

Many attendees commented on location and the focus the locations give to Des Moines. Questions were asked about membership cost and construction materials for roofing. It was suggested that the District post site location, description, and design options on the website for the public to review. District General Manager Deschenes indicated this was in process.

Ryan Nachreiner presented on aquatic program developments. He indicated the designs are purpose driven depending on the more important types of activities indicated by the survey.

Questions were asked about a salt water pool environment. It was commented it was more expensive option and difficult to maintain due to the corrosive properties of the minerals. It was also asked about controlling water temperature for multi-purpose activities in a one-pool environment. Ryan indicated it could be accomplished with substantial heating equipment in an over-night scenario.

Other comments were made regarding flat roof design vs. pitched roof options and the challenges due to the amount of rainfall the Pacific NW receives.


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**ADJOURNMENT**






