



Frequently Asked Questions

Why is the pool closed?

The pool was closed in July to perform maintenance that included replacing the pool liner and tile surfaces. During the renovation, severe corrosion was found in the buried drain lines and circulation piping. Also the mortar bedding for the pool wall and deck tile was failing and had to be replaced. These underlying issues must be repaired first in order to reopen the pool. We take the safety of our swimmers seriously.

Is that the extent of the repairs?

When the underlying issues were detected, the District worked with contractors to vet out other possible issues. We're fairly certain this is the extent of the repairs, but the pool is 42 years old. This is a large capital project so it's possible that other issues could arise that would need to be addressed to make the pool safe for users. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

When will the pool reopen?

It is scheduled to reopen January 2018.

How can I get updates about the pool maintenance project and reopening?
