Dear Future Team Member,

Are you looking for a job that fits your busy academic and extracurricular schedule? Come join the new Mount Rainier Pool staff as a lifeguard and/or swim lesson instructor. The Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District is looking to hire over 25 staff members, who want to give back to the community, while being a part of a team.

If you do not have a certification, no problem. The District will pay certifications for staff that commit to working as a District employee for one year. Applicants must meet the requirements below:

- Swim 300 yards continuously, demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing.
- Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs.
- Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards, dive 7-10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point and exit the water without using a ladder. Swim goggles may *not* be used.

If you cannot complete these requirements now, the District will allow interested participants to use Mount Rainier Pool during specified times to train for the test.

Our community is diverse and as such, we are also looking for people that can help us to reach out to this community including bilingual staff. Please list all languages you can speak on your application.
