
**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the
Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District, King County Washington
Establishing an Increase in the Regular Property Tax Levy and Calculating the
Percentage of Such Increase**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District has held its public revenue source hearing and as met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2018; and


WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that the Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred and refunds made, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the District and in its best interest; now therefore,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Des Moines Pool Metropolitan Park District that an increase in the regular property tax levy, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred and refunds made is hereby authorized for the 2018 levy in the amount of \$382,004.50 which is a percentage increase of 19% from the previous year
