Scholarship Information – Kaiser Permanente

To be eligible for the Kaiser Permanente users must live within the boundaries of the following schools and be eligible for free or reduced lunch:

Highline: Des Moines Elementary, Madrona Elementary, Marvista Elementary, Midway Elementary, North Hill Elementary, Parkside Elementary

Federal Way: Sunnycrest Elementary, Star Lake Elementary, Mark Twain Elementary, Woodmont K-8

- Scholarships can be used for swim lessons up to P3/Y3.
- Families on Reduced Lunch are eligible for a 75% scholarship
- Families on Free Lunch are eligible for a 90% scholarship

Procedure:

- 1. Give the applicant Parental Release of information form and have them complete it. Be sure to use the one for your school district. Make sure the following is included:
 - Student's name
 - School they attend
 - Parents name
 - Address
 - Email
- 2. The pool manger will follow with the school district and confirm Free/reduced lunch.
- 3. Once confirmed, the manager will notify family of acceptance and they may register for classes. The front desk will go into your account and make a note that this is a scholarship account and students they will have 75-90% off on any future lessons for the remainder of the school year or until scholarship funding has been depleted. This form must be filled out annually.
